- Entry fees are 50p per exhibit, except for classes 1-3 which are free. All exhibitors are limited to two entries per class.
- Exhibitors are held to declare that their exhibits are “bona fide” of their own growing.
- Young people exhibiting should have their age clearly marked on their entry form
- Names must not be marked on exhibits
- The points awarded are as follows: First-5; Second-3; Third-1.
- Exhibits may not be removed until after the presentations of the trophies.
