PRIZES, POINTS AND TROPHIES

The shows is more about taking part than winning prizes. However, there are certificates and three cups to be awarded – one for the family with the most points, one for the adult with the most points and another for the child with the most points.

SHOW RULES

- This is an amateur show open to all.
- Entries for the show per item is 20p – Sections 1 and 2 are free
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries from professional, cooks, gardeners and crafts people.
- Trophies are awarded for one year only and must be returned to the show committee when requested
- All exhibits must be grown or made by the exhibitor
- Exhibitors can only submit one entry per section
- Exhibitors must provide their own containers, plates, etc
- The show Committee will not accept responsibility for any loss, error or damage, but reasonable care will be taken to avoid this
- The decision of the judges is final
- Any exhibits that are not collected by 4pm on the day of the event will be entered into auction at 4.30pm for charity or disposed of
- Exhibits must be submitted WITHOUT the name of the exhibitor on it – note will be made of submissions against the exhibitor as they are submitted
- *Photocopies of this entry form are accepted*
- *Show timetable is outlined below – please note final time to collect entries, after which items left behind will be auctioned off and the proceeds given to the Air Ambulance charity – the nominated charity of the event*
