Policy for the use of Lilbourne Road Car Park

The Lilbourne Road car park is owned and maintained by Clifton upon Dunsmore Parish Council. The car park is open for use by members of the public.

The below conditions must be adhered to by users of the car park:

1. Maximum period of stay in the car park is 12 hours (with no return within 6 hours)
2. Over-staying vehicles will be removed following 7 days' written notice to owners being placed on the windscreen of the vehicle (if registered with DVLA)
3. Over staying vehicles will be removed without notice if untaxed and ownership is unregistered with DVLA
4. No oversized vehicles, including caravans or motorhomes may park in the car park.
5. No sleeping in vehicles overnight
6. No tracked vehicles (except for maintenance) or any vehicle likely to cause damage to the surface are permitted to use this car park.
7. All parking in the car park is at the owner's risk.
8. Users are asked to respect the signs and park within the confines of the spaces provided.
9. BBQs, camp fires or any other type of fire are strictly forbidden.
10. All litter is to be taken home.

This policy will be reviewed within 3 years from date of adoption by the Parish Council
