



## MEMBERSHIP OF THE PARISH COUNCIL

- I declare that I am not disqualified from serving as a Member of Clifton upon Dunsmore Parish Council and that:
- I am aged 18 or over at the date of this election or appointment;
- I am a UK or commonwealth citizen / a citizen of the Republic of Ireland / a citizen of another Member state of the European Union;
- I am an elector of the parish, or;
- I have for the whole of the previous 12 months occupied (as owner or tenant) land or other premises in the parish, or; during the previous 12 months have worked in the parish (as your principal or only place of work), or; for the whole of the previous 12 months lived in the parish or within three miles of the parish boundary.

All Parish Councillors are required to sign the Code of Conduct.

### DISQUALIFICATIONS FOR CO-OPTION TO BEING A PARISH COUNCILLOR

#### Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972

1. If you hold a paid office with the Parish Council; or other place of profit in the gift or disposal of the Council.
2. If you are subject to a Bankruptcy Restrictions Order or an interim Order. Note – the disqualification dates from the Judgement or Execution and generally ends one year after the relevant Order is made.
3. If you have within five years before the date of appointment been convicted in the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man of any offence and has been sentenced to not less than three months' imprisonment (whether suspended or not) without the option of a fine
4. You may be disqualified under any enactment relating to corrupt or illegal practices under the Representation of the People Act 1983. The names of any such persons are found in a special list which is published with the Electoral Register.
